**OLD BUSINESS:**

Cardinal Hoop organization can match only \$1000 for backboards. Currently, having some financial start up problems. After much discussion a motion was made to contribute the \$2000 to complete the financial transaction of the backboards. **NEW BUSINESS:**

Jack Gunderson talked about gym time and Cardinal Flight girls are not getting a fair share of practice times. Jack will talk with Dick Hebert about scheduling time problems. One of the problems we have run into is that the elementary school gets out of school at 2:30PM and Middle School and High School get out at 3:40PM.

**HOME TOURNAMENTS:**

When we hold tournaments we make good share of our revenue. In year of 2004, we held 6 - 1 tournaments and 2-2 day tournaments. In year of 2005, we held 4 - 1-day tournaments and 1-2 day tournament. Been discussing about having home tournaments, it was decided that all grades 5th - 8th, red or white team will have a home tournament.

Talked about having a 3-3 tournament in the future. Kip Knez will look into it more. Possible dates would be during Pure Water Fest and Octoberfest. This will help raise money for the organization.

#### COACHES REPORT:

5th Grade white - Alma Center tournament won 3 and lost 1 - took 2nd place

5th Grade red - Lake Holcombe tournament won 3 - lost 1 - took 5th place - came down to triple tie breaker (1) point on defensive points.

6th Grade white - Lake Holcombe tournament won 1 and lost 3 - took 5th place

6th Grade red - Lake Holcombe tournament won 4 and lost 0 - took 1st place. Last minute sign up for the tournament. At the 6th grade tournament took 8th place.

7th Grade white - Bloomer tournament won 5th place.

7th Grade red - Tournament will be held on December 10th and took 1st. Played at Stillwater and took 1st place.

8th Grade took 1st place recently. Scrimmage the 9th grade girls and one of the 8th grade girls broke her collarbone.

#### OTHER BUSINESS:

If we would have the Blugold girls come in for instruction, the cost is around \$250 per day. Budgeted up to \$1000. Talked about getting coaches from outside to come in also. Discussed to table the Blugold instruction time to come maybe in the fall of this coming year and have them come up to four different times.

Talked about replacing basketballs for the Chippewa Falls Cardinals. Cost is around \$800 for about 30 basketball.

Talked about JV basketball players keeping score, for the Cardinal Flight program. Talked about what should be done about the amount of food the score keepers eat, but do not have to pay for. After much discussion it was decided that the score keeper will get one menu ticket that will cover for a sandwich, drink and dessert. Mary Schnobrich will put together some examples of menu tickets to be used at the tournaments.

Referees get \$25.00 per game

6th Grade White tournament will be held on February 3rd. Need a tournament director. Mary Schnobrich nominated her husband "Scott" to be the director.

#### BUS TRIP TO MADISON:

Handed out information to all coaches to give to their team members on the up coming bus trip to Madison in March. Last year we lost money, due the people sign up and then the day of the trip did not show up to ride the bus or get their tickets. This year money will need to be paid up front for the bus and tickets. Deadline for ordering tickets is January 23rd.

Basketball Budget: There was talk that we have one bag of balls for home tournaments only.

Motion made by Mary Schnobrich to support the continued basketball exchange when requested and the old basketballs will be used by Cardinal flight organization and 2nd Kathy Facklam.

An amended motion was made to hold funds for the high school needs for basketballs, when needed. Motion was made by Mary Schnobrick and Kip Knez to hold the price of new basketballs up to \$800.
